**Application for variation of Section 36 Consent to construct and operate the MeyGen Tidal Energy
Electricity Generating Station**

Please accept this letter and the enclosed Section 36C Variation Report as an application under Section 36C of the Electricity Act 1989 to vary the consent granted under Section 36 of the Electricity Act 1989 to MeyGen Limited on 9th October 2013.

The Section 36 Consent authorises MeyGen to construct and operate Phase 1 of the MeyGen Tidal Energy Electricity Generating Station with a maximum generation capacity of 86 MW and located in the Inner Sound, Pentland Firth, all as more fully described in Annex 1 (Description of the Development) to the Section 36 Consent.

The variation application seeks to amend the 'Phase 1 area for turbine deployment' outlined in red and shown in the Figure in Annex 3 of the Section 36 Consent to include an additional area to the north-west of the site and to remove a similar sized area from the eastern side of the current area for turbine deployment.

The amendments proposed to the Figure in Annex 3 of the Section 36 Consent are shown in the Section 36C Variation Report accompanying this letter which also provides details of the reasons for the proposed variation.

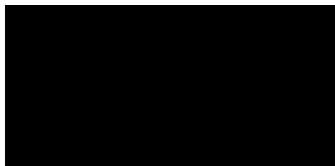
